Inasmuch as I have never
heard directly from you ^{upon musical matters} I feel like
the liberty to submit to your consid-
eration a proposition. I met Prof.
Wilson on the train going to Salt
Lake City - Saturday and we conversed
some upon the conditions in Lagon. I be-
lieve he said you had mentioned me
to him. He stated it was your desire
to have a man that would remain
right there. Now if you should still
think favorable of me. I have this
to offer. If your institution desires
to give me a salary (a reasonable con-

compensation, allow me to have what I make from outside teaching. You of course furnishing all that is necessary for school equipment. I would transfer our Conservatory to your college which would mean a great many pupils going from our school here to your place. It would also give us a showing next year in having a class for graduation, as we have some pupils here to graduate next year. If you desired to do this giving me the aforesaid compensation I would be willing to assume the directorship and do the vocal work feeling sure it could be carried to success. As we are having fine success in our work here, but I feel if we were connected with your college it would give us a broader field to draw from all over the state.
