Dear Sir:

In compliance with request in letter from Secretary Mattson of the State Board of Examiners addressed to you and ^{which} ~~was~~ referred to me for answer, I have prepared a statement of all of the Insurance carried by this Institution and am forwarding same to him to-day. I am also submitting to you enclosed herewith a copy of same for your information and for the information of the Board of Trustees should they desire same at their annual Meeting.

I beg to call your attention to the fact that we are carrying no insurance whatever on the State Power Plant. In regard to the rate which we are paying you will notice that it is \$9.00 per thousand and for three years in Board Companies and \$8.50 per thousand in non-board Companies. Although this was a very good rate at the time we secured same it is my opinion that we should be able to secure a better rating on our property at the present time.

Dear Sir:

Your letter of the 20th inst. addressed to President J. A. Widtsoe of this Institution and asking for a list of our Insured property with the name of the Company in which it is insured and the rate per year we are paying, is at hand and has been referred to me for answer.
