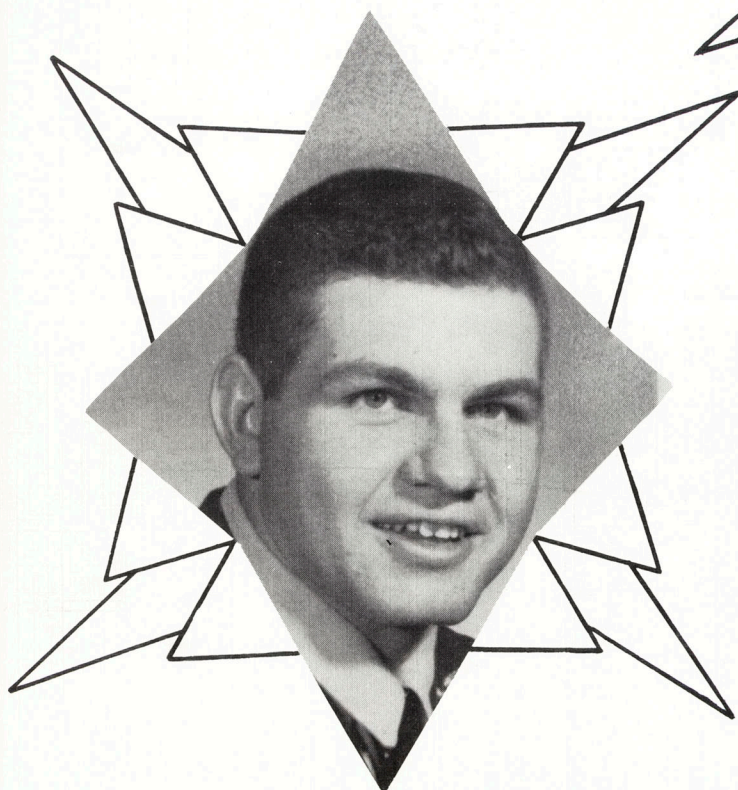


# STUDENT BODY OFFICERS
