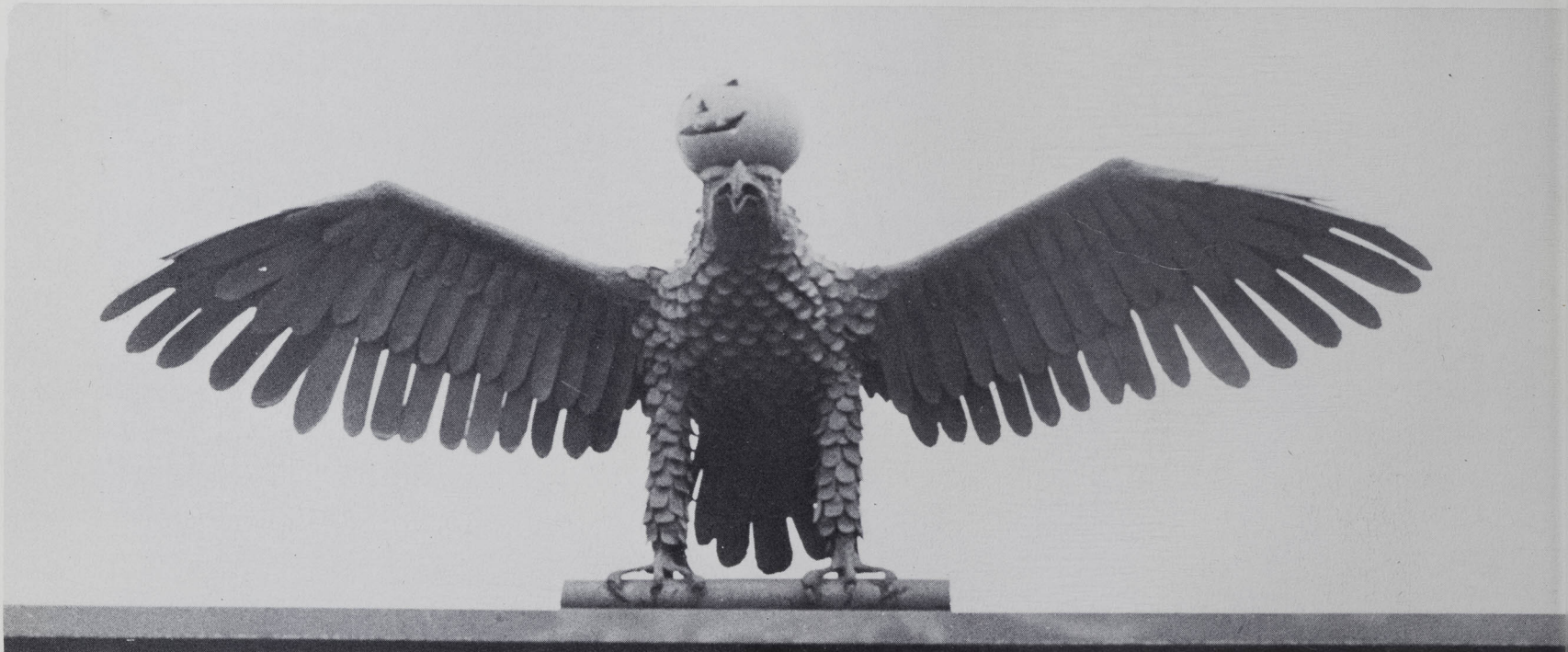
Homecoming And Halloween Join Forces

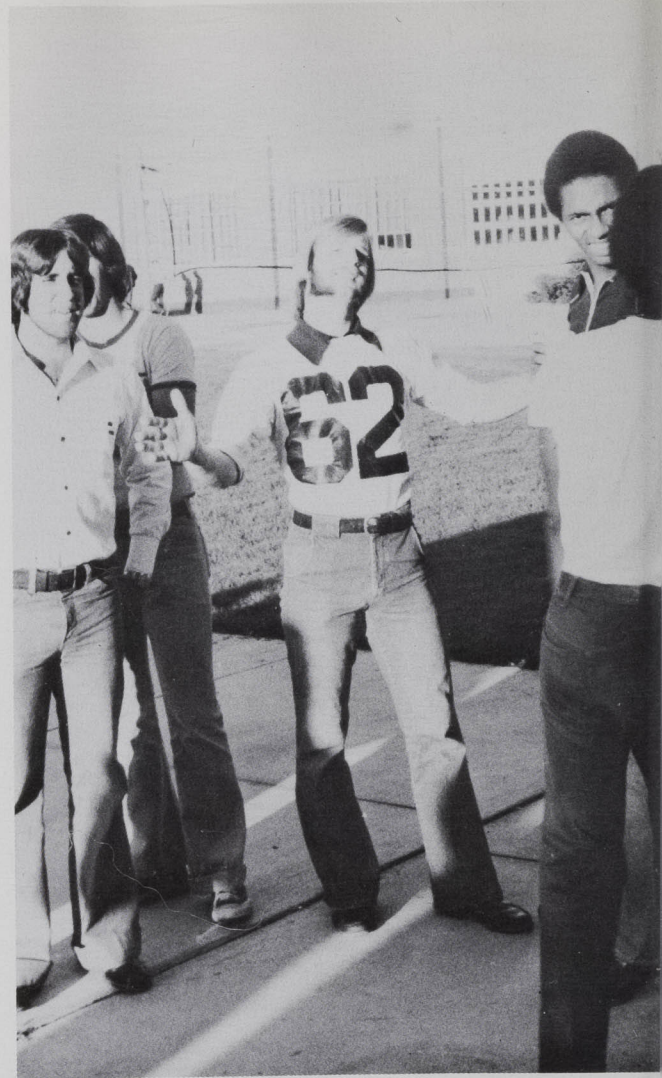

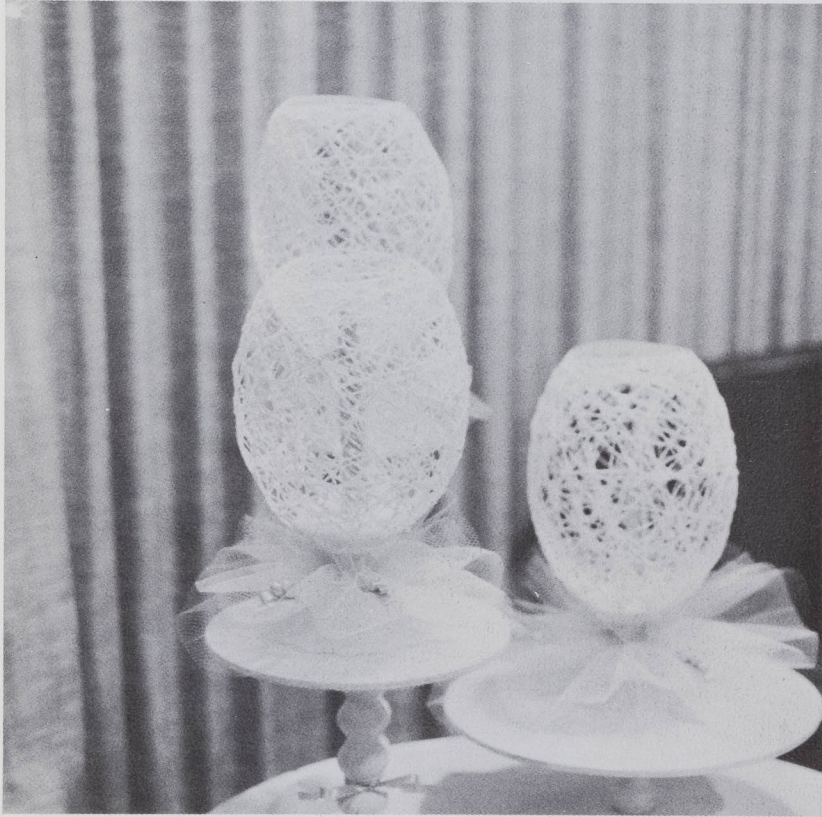

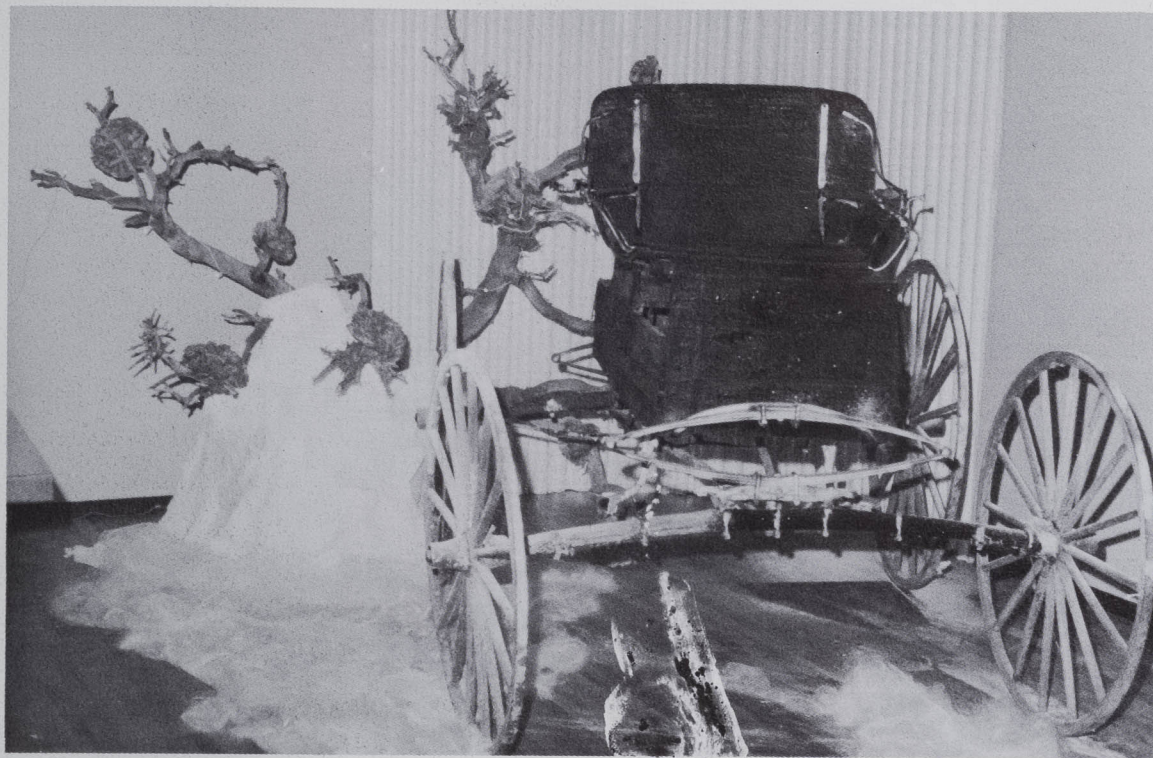

Preference Ball



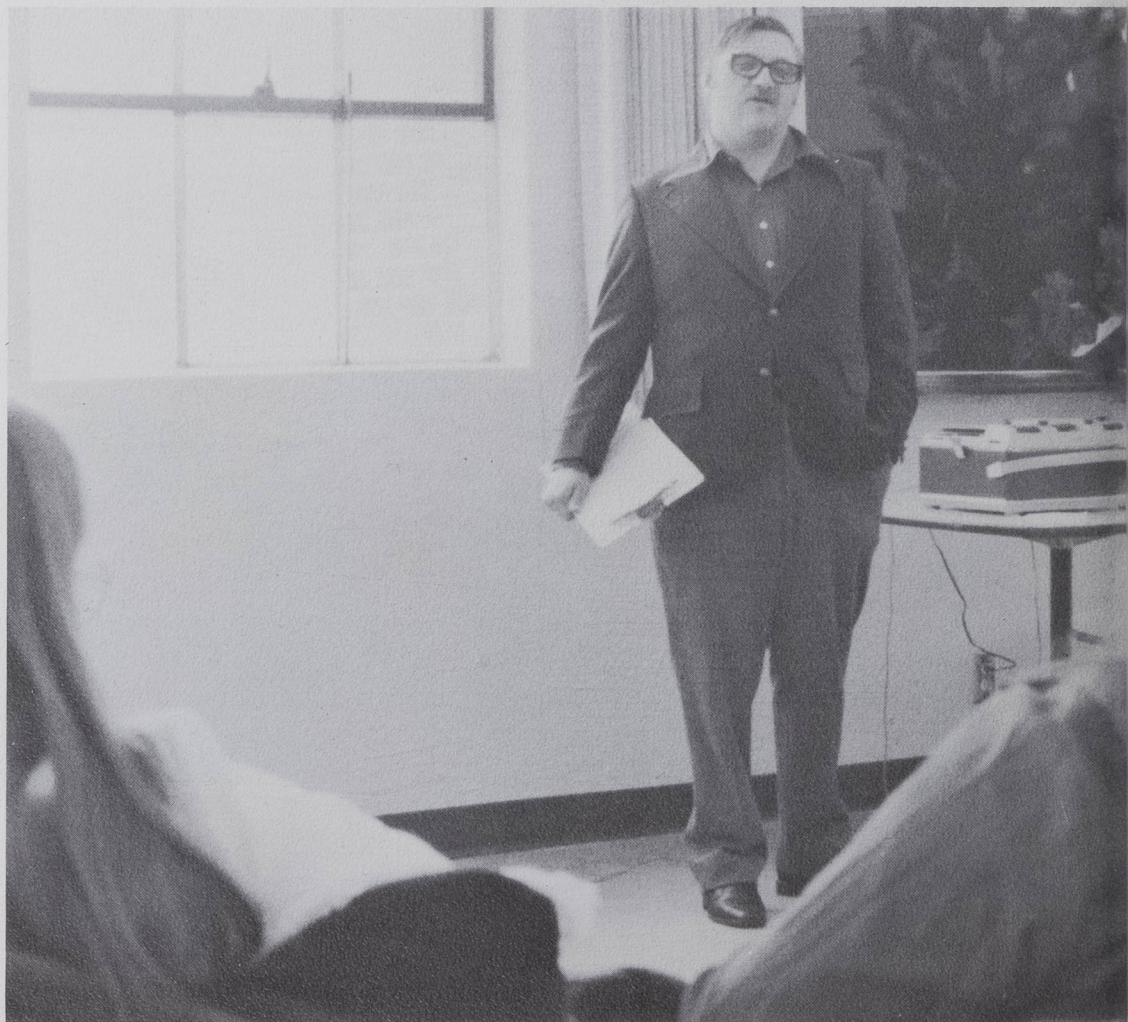
Richard Dennison was chosen as the most preferred man on campus.
