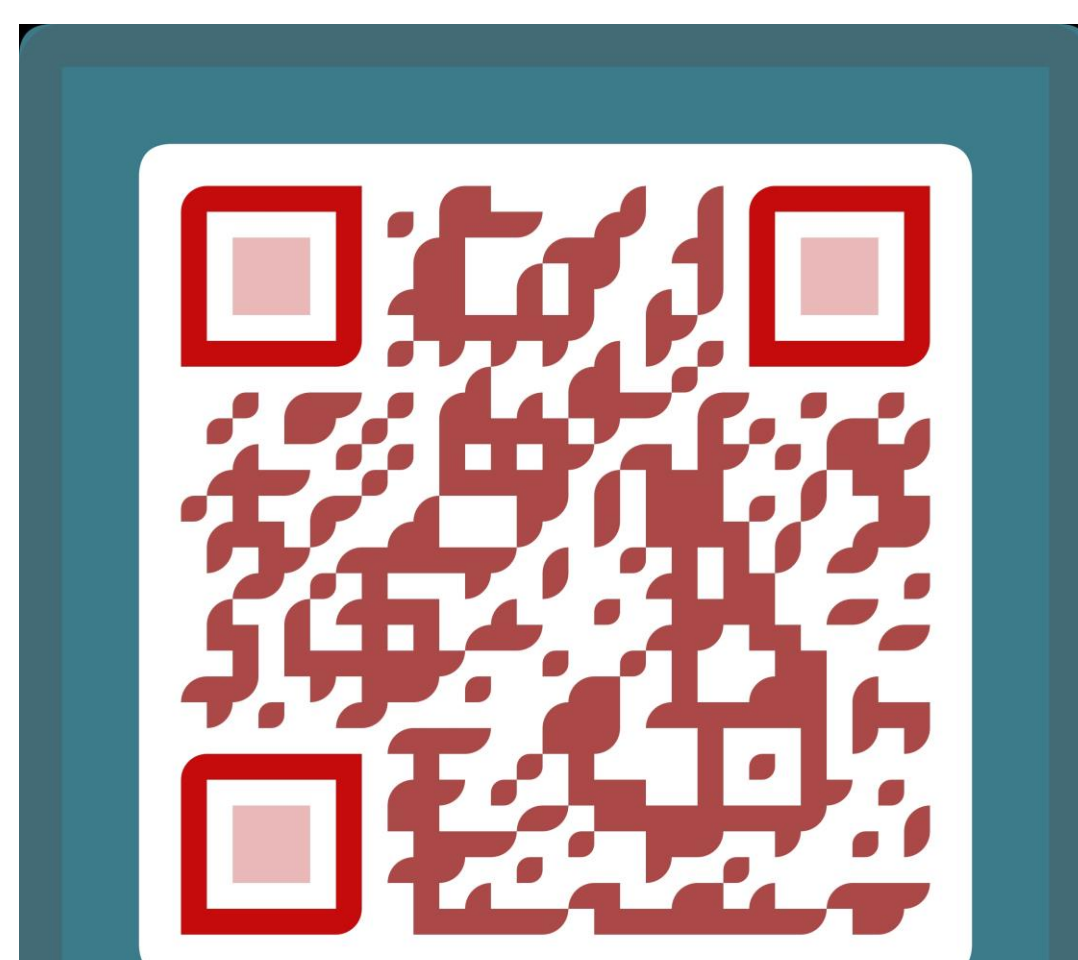

Method of research

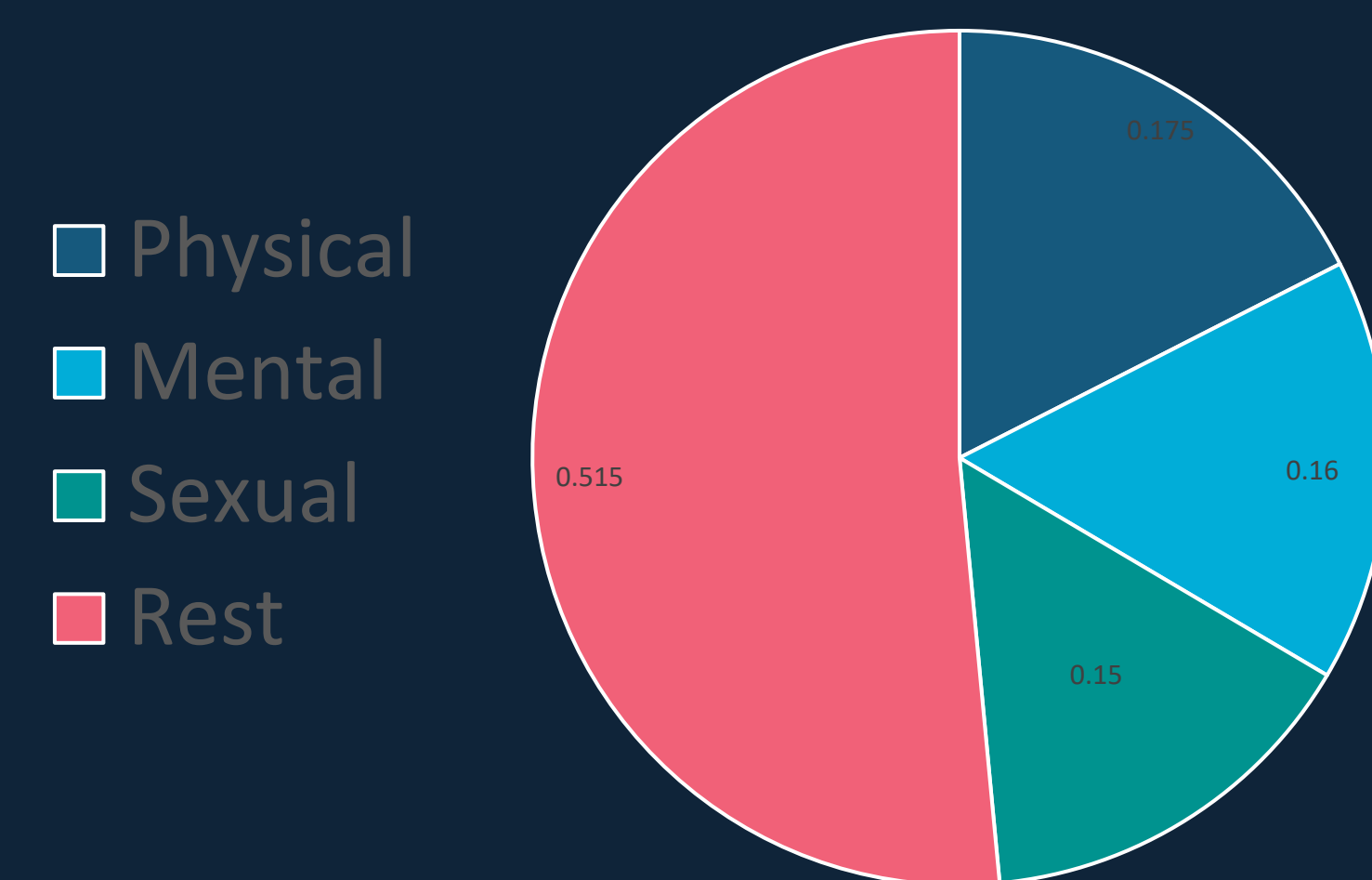

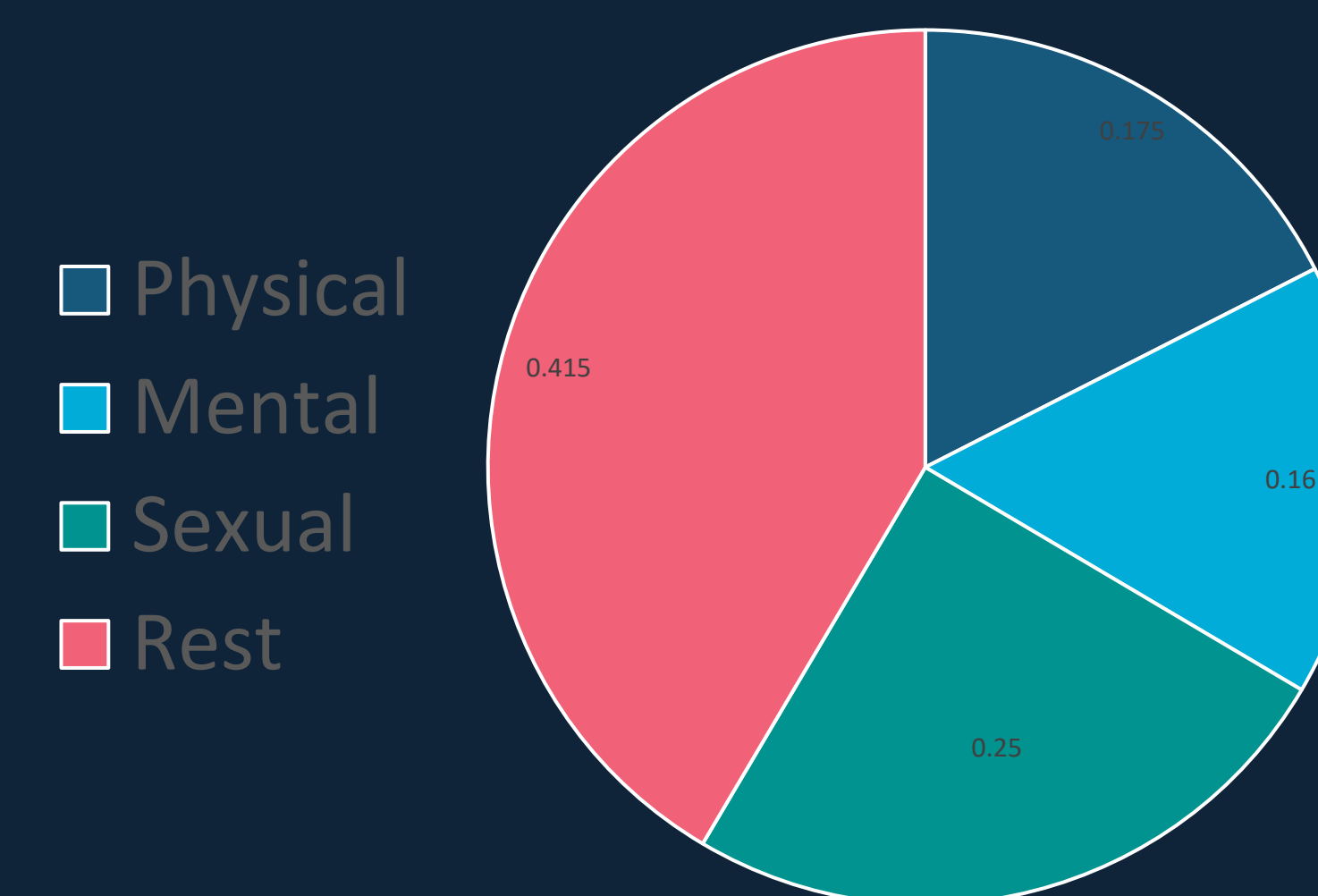
Though past childhood maltreatment can hurt marriages when steps are taken those marriages will become strong

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Findings
