1. What appropriations are made by the State Legislature for the support of the government experiment station?

2. Are any sub-stations, located in different parts of the state, maintained? If so, what amount is appropriated for their maintenance?

3. Are the sub-stations restricted to any special line of work?

5. Are any industrial or agricultural schools maintained in connection with, or independent of, the land grant college of your state? If so, where are they located, to what special line of work is each limited, and what amount is appropriated by the State Legislature for the support of each?
