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Acoustic-Prosodic Entrainment in the Context of Autism Spectrum Disorder

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RESOURCE SHARING PLAN

Sharing of data generated by this project with the academic and clinical community is an essential part of our proposed activities and will be carried out through different means. Details are described below.

The behavioral data supporting publications will be available for public access via Open IPCSR. All data stored for public access will be de-identified. Any HIPAA-protected information will be maintained and shared according to approved university IRB protocols. A data-sharing plan will be in place which will require that the individual use the data and stimuli only for research purposes, that they only use de-identified data, and that they appropriately secure the data.

We will make the results of our studies available both to the academic and clinical communities interested in autism spectrum disorder, and to the larger scientific community engaged in conversational research. Our results sharing plan includes (i) Presentations at national scientific meetings: It is expected that two presentations at national or international meetings would be appropriate. These may include meetings such as Interspeech and/or the American Speech and Hearing Association Conference; (ii) Publications in peer-reviewed journals: We expect that the findings of this study will be of interest to the broader interactional research community. We will submit our findings to the relevant ASHA journals and to journals with a broader audience, such as the *Journal of Phonetics*, and the *Journal of Speech Communication*; and (iii) Website: We will use the Sponsor's website to help share new results and make papers available as appropriate.
