Dear Sir:-

Your letter of the 13th inst. received and contents noted.

In regard to my record, I will state that I have had the ordinary preparatory education to college and spent one year in the Liberal Arts College of Syracuse University, and then took a degree from the Syracuse University College of Law, and was admitted to practice as an attorney in this state in July 1903.

I played four years on the Varsity team, having played two years at guard and center and the last two years was shifted to right half-back.

In the fall of 1903, I coached the Missouri School of Mines eleven, and this year I captained and coached the All-Collegiates of the City of Syracuse, which is composed of old college players, and also assisted in coaching the University team.

I also played four years on the Varsity base ball team as catcher and outfielder, and captained the team in my senior year. I am twenty six years of age and unmarried.

I have just been looking over your catalogue which arrived this morning, and am very favorably impressed with it and think it must be a very progressive college.
