MEMORANDA CONCERNING HOTELS IN THE VICINITY OF COPLEY SQUARE.
Revised Dec. 28, 1902.

- 124
- COPLEY SQUARE:** European Plan for all, or American Plan for all -- no combination of the two; accommodations for 100 persons. On the former, \$1.50 to \$3 a day per room with \$1 more for each additional occupant. American Plan, \$3.50 to \$5. Probably average price, European Plan, \$2; American Plan, \$4.
- NOTTINGHAM:** European Plan, accommodation for about 100. Rooms \$2 for two persons, \$1.50 for one person. American Plan, \$2 in addition to room as above.
- LENOX:** European Plan, accommodation for about 200 persons. Rooms \$2.50, \$3 and upward for two in a room.
- OXFORD:** Rooms \$1 a day per person for two in a room; extra cots fifty cents. Accommodations for about 75. Meals probably \$1 a day.
- WESTMINSTER:** Accommodations for about 100. Single rooms \$1.50 per day and upwards. Double bedroom for two persons \$2.50 per day and upwards. Suites of large room, reception hall and bath for one or three persons \$5 per day. Suites of two rooms and bath for one or four persons \$7 per day. Suites of three rooms for one or seven persons with bath \$12 per day.
- VENDOME:** American Plan; accommodation for about 200 persons. The regular rate is \$5 and upwards, and a "convention discount" of 20% would be granted.
- BRUNSWICK:** American Plan; accommodation for about 250 persons; \$4 a day, one in a bed and room; \$3.50 a day for two in a bed and room; several parlors on the first floor and a hall capable of seating 250 persons available for headquarters -- without charge in consideration of the hotel being well filled.
- BERKELEY:** Accommodations for about 150. One room and bed, two persons, \$1 each person; with meals \$3.00 each. Rooms occupied by one person \$1.50 to \$2; with meals \$3.50; the same with bath \$2.50; including meals \$4.
- THORNDIKE:** European plan; rooms \$2, two in a room. Same with bath \$2.50 to \$3. Corresponding rates one person, \$1, \$1.50 and \$2.
- SOMERSET:** Accommodations for about 200. The Somerset is wholly European. Special rates will be granted as follows:
