Dear Sir:-

If you are in need of a football coach I would deem it
a favor to correspond with your athletic authorities.

I have had six years experience, serving as assistant
under such well known men as Dr. Carl Williams - late Head Coach
at the University of Pennsylvania - and Dr. N. P. Stauffer - the
well known official - and for the last four years have been Head
Coach at Richmond (Va.) College (1903) and Gettysburg (Pa.) Coll-
ege (1904-1906). I can show the highest testimonials from all
the places I have coached, including endorsements from the
Presidents of both Colleges. As an instance of steady develop-
ment I will cite Gettysburg. In 1903 (I was at Richmond)
Pennsylvania beat them 72 - 0. I was in charge 1904, 1905 and
1906 and cut down the scores steadily, thus: 1904, 21-0,
1905, 16-6, and 1906, 6-6.
