My dear Sir:

Mr. Madison of the Logan Power Company has just informed me that they are very anxious to have the matter of the installation of the lighting and power system of the College adjusted without delay. While he suggested that they will be glad to cooperate with us in any way they can, yet they did not feel justified in allowing the matter to go longer without adjustment.

If the trustees desire, a meeting could be called for Saturday, Jan. 23d, so that they could be present at the opening of the Musical Department and have the expenses of their visit to the city paid.

If you could be here a couple of days next week, I could notify Trustee Owen, and the Committee could meet, look over the specifications prepared by Prof. Jenson, and reach a decision on how to proceed in the matter of the installation of the sub-station and auxiliary lines.
