## FREE HOME REPAIRS AVAILABLE FOR SALT LAKE CITY RESIDENTS

Salt Lake City has partnered with World Changers, a national volunteer organization, to provide free home repairs for Salt Lake City residents.

Homeowners must be low-income, elderly, or disabled to qualify for the services. The homeowner does not have to pay for the services and materials they receive. Possible repairs or additions include wheelchair ramps, repair or replacement of roofs, vinyl siding replacement or painting, window repairs, deck or patio repairs, fences, yard and landscape clean-up, and other projects as approved.

The services will take place in June, 2011. Eligible individuals can find out more about this program and apply online. Application deadline is February 15, 2011.
