I am informed that you will need an additional instructor in Mathematics for the Agricultural College the coming year, therefore make application for the position.

I am a Normal Graduate of the University of Utah of 1893, and have since attended the same institution one year, 1898-99, specializing in Mathematics, holding at present a State High School Diploma, which I received in 1901.

I have had seven years experience in teaching, including the present year, four of which were in the District Schools of Utah and Idaho, and three in the High Schools of Utah including the present year in the Salt Lake High School;

the other two years having been spent in the Academy at Ogden. My principal work in the high schools has been in Mathematics and History. I am teaching Algebra and Geometry at present in the Salt Lake High School.

I am, perhaps, well enough known in Cache to make it unnecessary for me to give references as to character and personal habits, but may refer you to Mr J. J. Stewart ^{of} ~~and~~ Frank R. Hebecker of Logan on that point.

With reference to salary may say that judging from ^{my} present salary and the possible advance for next year, that I am warranted in asking about \$900. per year. tho not stipulating an amount which is not subject to change.
