Scot Allgood moved to approve the request to revise the GPA admission standards for pre-nursing students at Utah State University. Richard Mueller seconded; motion carried.

Felix Tweraser moved to approve the Art Department request to merge the current emphases of “Painting and Drawing” into a single emphasis area titled “Drawing and Painting”. Norm Jones seconded; motion carried.

Richard Mueller moved to approve the proposal to establish an interdisciplinary Undergraduate Minor in Latin American Studies housed in the College of Humanities, Arts, and Social Sciences. Scot Allgood seconded. Motion was approved pending approval of the BFW committee.

The School of Graduate Studies approved degrees, specializations, and certificates were FYI items. There seems to be a discrepancy between this list and what is listed in the General Catalog.
