Revolutionary War Only Course Offered At Columbia In 1795

New York, N. Y.—His majesty,
the king of England, granted to the
state of New York in 1754 a
charter for a college to be called
King's college. The eight young
men comprising the entire student
body at that time, upon entering,
were faced with a serious, virtuous
task. They had to choose between
the study of the sciences and the
study of the humanities. The
work was begun under Dr. Samuel
Johnson, the first president.
The college was named after his
name and moved back into their
class rooms. Their only course for
seven years was the Revolutionary
War. Play years after the Treaty
of Paris, the Royal Charter was con-
firmed by the legislature of the
state of New York. The college of
the University of New York, was
incorporated, and the property of
King's college was vested in them.
Enjoying their new won demo-
cracy, and obeying to a name or
thing having anything to do with
their former parents, the col-
lege changed its name to "Colum-
bia".
