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
Russian Strategic Deterrence (sderzhivanye)

Fear inducement

- Demonstrative acts
- Dissuasion
- Peacetime/military threat

Limited use of force

- Threats to critical targets
- Inflict "unacceptable damage"
- Imminent threat/conflict outset
